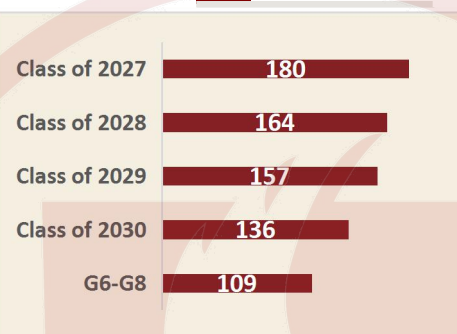
OVERVIEW

CURRICULUM & GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

SCHEDULE

- School year includes: Two semesters comprised of approximately 18 weeks.
- Modified block schedule: six periods per day, with each class lasting 50 minutes. For one-on-one courses, at least 60 class hours are required to complete 1.0 credit, and AP courses require a minimum of 80 class hours. There is also a summer session available, allowing students who complete the required credits for graduation to graduate early.
- All students (grades 9-12) must take six courses per semester.

Each semester class is 0.5 credits. For the students who transfer to our school for graduation, they need to provide the transcripts from the 9th grade of their previous school and complete the remaining credit courses according to the graduation requirements of our school. The credits taken in our school must include the required courses for Grade 12, and should not be less than 1/4 of the credits required for graduation (i.e. 6 credits). The cumulative GPA of all courses (including transfer credits) shall not be lower than 2.0.

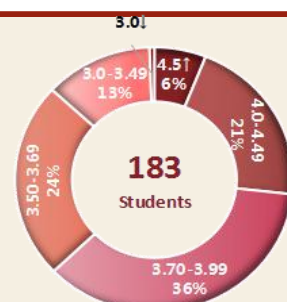

Obridge Academy does not report class rank. Transfer course grades are calculated using the Obridge grading scale. The GPA is based on a weighted 4.0 scale and includes courses from Obridge and other high schools. Honors and AP® courses add 0.5 and 1.0 points, respectively, to the GPA. Students can begin AP® courses in 10th grade, limited to two in 10th and four in 11th and 12th grades. Additional AP® class requests require approval.

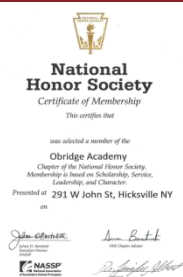

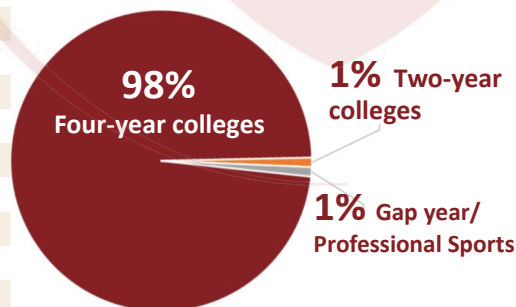

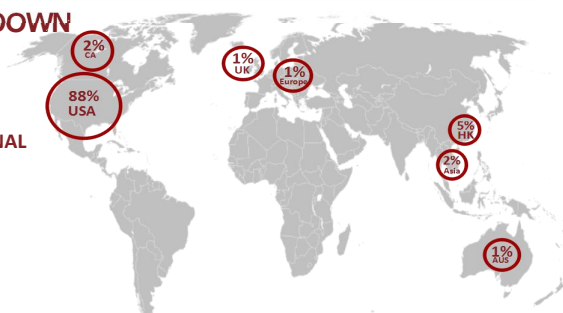
COLLEGE GEOGRAPHIC BREAKDOWN
